| NATER METERS – The location of the water meter on the property will be determined by the SUPPLIER. Any new water taps installed and serviced by MUC shall have a meter installed and billed monthly according to the gallons used specified by the current water rate ordinance. All Industrial and Commercial users shall be metered. It is understood and agreed that the SUPPLIER reserves the right to determine the size connection to be used to supply water to the USER. A 5/8 inch by 3/4 inch meter will be used unless the USER contracts for a larger meter. A separate meter must be installed for each residence. A separate contract will be used by mobile home parks when mobile home parks are not supplied by individual meters. Meters larger than 5/8 inch by 3/4 inch meter, requested by the USER, shall be subject to actual costs of installation of same. Adjustments to an account due to leaks may be done once a year at the discretion of MUC.  WATER TAPS – New tap on fees are set forth in the current water tap Ordinance adopted by the City of Monticello.  BACKFLOW PREVENTION – and Cross-Connection control devices shall be installed on certain water connections at the owner's expense as deemed necessary by MUC in accordance with Ordinance 50s.
